#### LAST MEETING WRAP UP - 16 NOVEMBER

Queensland Champion Scott Thomsen was a deserved winner in Round One of the AWSR Wide Open Clothing Wingless Sprint Series at Hi-Tec-Oils Toowoomba Speedway on Saturday night. In a night of frantic racing as valuable series points were up for grabs for some drivers and teams, if it wasn't for bad luck they would be having no luck at all. Thomsen managed to avoid misfortune as he negotiated his way through the quality field made up of Australia's best Wingless Sprintcar drivers. He was on the pace from the start setting a quick time of 13.813 at a speed of 97.7 kph. In his first heat he finished 3rd and won his second heat and in doing so qualified for the night's feature from position 1 leading all the way to win the 30 lap opening round. Thomsen finished ahead of Victorian Brad Warren, New South Wales driver Brad McCarthy finished third. South Australia's Jack McCarthy finished fourth and Rylan Furler rounded out the top five.







Bruce Marshall won the AMCA feature after having to work at it all race long to get the race won in round 4 of the Stows Transport Series. The current National Champion is now looking toward the defence of his Australian Title on March 7th and 8th next year in Toowoomba. In the Late Models Toowoomba's Jordan Cunningham finished second to a very dominant Daniel Cassidy from Sydney and Carter Armstrong finishing third.

Darren Ciesiolka got the win in the Street Stocks main event in the Engage Ag Ironman Series round 2. Luke Wilkinson was the early race leader in the second half of the feature race but with a few laps remaining Ciesiolka slipped by on the bottom line to take over the race lead and raced away to win from Luke Wilkinson and Ricky Gill.



The Formula 500s produced some fast and entertaining racing with Liam Williams running the high banks in style, he was running around the top of the racetrack for most of the race. A hard charging Bailey Leeson finished second from Amanda Chaffey who finished third. In the Juniors Blake Duggan was first to greet the checkered flag from Ari Perry and Sam Nucifora Jnr third. Thanks to Forza Global for making this series possible.

In the Junior Sedans Top Stars Jackson Kunny won the their feature from Tyler Beer and Toowoomba's Lachie Burke.

The New Stars feature race was taken out by Jaiden Houldsworth who got the win from Kaitlyn Humphreys and Lucas Welke.

### **KICKING UP THE DIRT – 2 NOVEMBER**

Sprintcars returned to Hi-Tec Oils Toowoomba Speedway on 2 November 2024, for Round Two of the Ultimate Sprintcar Championship, and Round Two of the Field the Label 360-LS Sprintcar series. Lachlan McHugh prevailed after taking advantage of a late race caution in the 30-lap finale for the open division, with Brock Hallett home in second and Ryan Newton rounding out the podium. Nicholas Whell had a sensational run in the Q21 racer to claim fourth ahead of Luke Oldfield.



In the 360-LS Sprintcars Jacob Jolley and Ryley Smith had a brilliant battle for top honours, with Smith eventually gracing the top podium step. Jolley crossed the line second with Kye Jensen home in third to complete the top three. Luke Manttan and Tyler Burnham rounded out the top five after a thrilling battle with Brian Walsh.

Brock Hallett was the quickest of the Open Sprintcars in their qualifying session, Hallett stopping the clock at 11.769 seconds. Lachlan McHugh was second quickest (11.840) ahead of Dylan Menz (11.877), Luke Oldfield (11.897) and Nicholas Whell (11.968). The top twenty-one drivers were separated by less than one second, with just 0.065 of a second the difference between making the top eighteen inversion, and a tough night racing from the rear of the field. 360-LS Qualifying saw Dan Murray top the leader board with a 12.327 second lap ahead of Kye Jensen (12.332), Ryley Smith (12.486), Jacob Jolley (12.539) and Brian Walsh (12.618). 360-LS Sprintcar heat winners were Ryley Smith (x2), Brian Walsh and Jacob Jolley.

Sprintcar heat races went the way of Ryan Newton from Aaron Kelly and Brock Hallett, Cody O'Connell then held off fast finishing Lockie McHugh and Harry Stewart in heat two, while Brodie Davis won heat three from Luke Oldfield and Tim Farrell.

The Sprintcar A-Main began with Lachlan McHugh and Brock Hallett from the front row. Hallett got the initial jump, McHugh challenged as they rounded the second turn, while Ryan Newton sat in third ahead of Luke Oldfield. McHugh got underneath Hallett a couple of laps into the race, leaving Hallett under pressure from Newton and Oldfield. Mid field Brodie Davis, Jy Corbet, Brent Kratzmann, Aaron Kelly and Harry Stewart had a fierce battle for minor positions, with Stewart, having just won the Speedcar feature event moments before strapping into the Sprintcar, taking to the high line as he made his way ahead of Corbet and began challenging Kelly and Kratzmann. Kelly and Stewart traded positions back and forth several times before Stewart secured the advantage and turned his focus to Kratzmann as they edged closer to Davis and as Callum Walker from the B-Main closed in behind. Out in front McHugh had control as Hallett closed in and began to challenge for the lead as they approached lapped traffic. Oldfield had a big but unsuccessful look under Newton, before surrendering a position to Whell, while Hallett made his way underneath McHugh with thirteen laps remaining. Hallett pulled away while Newton got under McHugh to steal second leaving McHugh to defend third from a determined Whell. McHugh and Newton traded slide jobs with five laps to run, and continued to do so several times a lap for the next couple of laps, until a caution two laps from home left a three-lap sprint to the chequered flag.

Hallett led as the race restarted with McHugh and Newton right behind. McHugh got around the outside of Hallett with two laps to run, Hallett challenged on the bottom with one to run, they drag-raced across the line with Lachlan McHugh taking the win by 0.660 seconds. Brock Hallett finished second and Ryan Newton third. Nicholas Whell and Luke Oldfield rounded out the top five, with Dylan Menz sixth ahead of an impressive Callum Walker who claimed seventh after transferring from the B-Main. Kaydon Iverson, Brodie Davis and Harry Stewart rounded out the top ten, with Brent Kratzmann, Cody O'Connell, Tim Farrell, Aaron Kelly, Anthony Lambert, Jy Corbet, Jayden Peacock, Richard Morgan and Nathan Pronger rounding out the finishers. Adam Butler was the only starter who failed to finish the event.

The Downs Speedway club was originally established in 1966-67 when racing was held at the old Toowoomba Showgrounds and continued there until 1974 when the Royal Agricultural Society announced they would promote speedway themselves. The then members of the club voted to establish their own grounds and in May 1975 the land at Charlton was purchased and many hard-working dedicated people spent a lot of hours working to establish this great complex that we enjoy today. The Down Speedway Club's Charlton Raceway complex was opened on 23 April 1977.

The club ran and operated the venue successfully until the 2013/14 season when become privately promoted by Alan Woods who operated the venue for two seasons until he sold the lease to Made Too Go Pty Ltd (Barry Waldron) in 2015 for the 2015/16 season.




