

KIDS IN PITS VEST PROGRAM

(RACE TEAMS ONLY / NOT GENERAL PUBLIC)

HOW IT WORKS:

- The child (under 16 without Speedway Australia Licence), must wear a high-vis vest all night while in the pit area. If you don't have a vest, our venue has some for sale.
- The parent must sign a waiver form at Pit Gate on entry to the venue (side window).
 - Must nominate the driver / team – assuming responsibility for child. Car number must be on vest.
- Parent and Child participating in the program will wear armband all night.
- Parent and all Children participating in the program will all pay normal Pit Entry price.
- No more than 3 children under the control of one adult.
- Maximum of 3 children can be nominated to a driver / team on any given event.

RULES:

- Children must be **supervised and be within 3m of an adult at all times** and can only be in their pit bay / transporter, toilet, viewing areas or canteens. Children cannot be in the common areas unless moving from area (passing through with their parent / guardian).
- Children must be in the trailer or not within 5m when race cars are being pushed in and out of the pit area.
- Children must be in the trailer or not within 5m of the race car when it is jacked up or being refuelled.
- Children cannot be in a race car when the car is moving or has been started.
- Enclosed shoes must be worn at all times.
- Minimum dress standards in the pit area is T-Shirt and shorts. (eg. No singlets etc)
- The Dummy Grid, Track, Infield and Hotzone are restricted areas for Speedway Australia licence holders only (no children). These areas have been fenced off.

NEW PIT RULES:

- All cars coming off the track must stop in the Hotzone, before moving back to the pit paddock.
- Speed limit in pits is 5 km/h (walking pace) for race cars with clutches, recovery vehicles etc
- Cars without gearboxes / clutches (eg. Sprintcars, Speedcars, Wingless) will be required to be pushed back to their trailers. Mules /Quad rules still apply and must be operated at walking pace.

MISC:

Breaking of any of these rules / regulations, will result in offending parent, children being removed from the racetrack and the driver given a \$500 fine, immediate exclusion from the event and placed on the Speedway Australia Standdown list until the fine is paid. Unpaid fines will also result in both the driver and children / guardian being excluded from being able to enter our pit. Continued breaches will result in heavier fines and suspensions.

The normal afternoon "pit walk" between 1pm & 3pm each afternoon for the general public and for racing families not wishing to participate in the Kids in Pits Vest Program will continue as normal.

PARTICIPATION IN THE KIDS IN PITS PROGRAM IS AT YOUR OWN RISK
